

WEEKEND SHORT RACES

1 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

The series is open to all FCYC and RFYC club member boats.

2 SCHEDULE OF RACE

The dates and times of the races are listed in the Club's Sailing Programme.

3 THE COURSE

The course will be selected by the OOD from those shown below, or any other course set at their discretion.

If WSR races are run using the RFYC Committee boat, courses will be chosen and displayed as per RFYC SIs.

Race duration will be approximately 1 – 1½ hours

4 THE START

The starting line will be between the mast of a Committee Boat displaying an orange flag and another mark designated by the OOD.

5 THE FINISH

The finishing line will be between the mast of the committee boat flying a Blue Flag and the mark of the course after the finish time.

6 SCORING

3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.

Discards will be added to the final series scores as follows:

The race officer on duty will be awarded average points based on the races they sail in the series.

7 PRIZES

A trophy will be awarded for 1st place in the series to be presented at the FCYC prizegiving.
